- During the introductory sessions, there will also be personnel available to answer questions from the offices of Student Services and Records, Financial Aid, and Learning Resources.
- Following the introductory session, there will be guided small-group tours. Each department will have displays and demonstrations to help clarify the roles of the various professions.
- You will have an opportunity to interact with current students from each program.
